2. All cadets will participate in an aircrew survival field training exercise (FTX) at Canadian Forces Maritime Experimental Testing Range Nanoose Bay (CFMETR) on 16/17 October 2021

Execution:

3. Advance Party Cadets (Selected Senior Cadets and Instructors) will arrive at the CFMETR Main Gate NLT

0800 hrs on 16 Oct 2021 Cadets will arrive in combats/bush gear and present themselves to the OIC.

4. All other Cadets will arrive at the CFMETR Main Gate NLT 0900 hrs on 16/17Oct 2021. Cadets will arrive in combats/bush gear or appropriate attire for outdoor activities. **Parents must not leave the drop off until Covid screening has been completed**

5. All cadets will cease training at 1600hrs and be picked up NLT then 1630hrs on 16 Oct 2021.

6. All cadets will cease training at 1430hrs and be picked up NLT then 1500hrs on 17 Oct 2021.

7. Cadets must arrange their own transportation to and from CFMETR.

8. Cadets arriving must arrive having eaten a good breakfast.

Service Support:

9. Rations (MRE's) will be provided for the weekend. Special dietary concerns cannot be addressed. Contact the OIC if dietary concerns exist.

10. A kit list is attached and should be adhered to as close as possible. This kit list is standard but dependent on season as well. Cadets will be turned away if they do not have the minimum kit for the season.

11. Cadets should not bring money or valuables on this exercise.

12. Cadets are required to wear masks and social distance while on this exercise.

13. COVID safety standards must be adhered to by all.
